

Things to be Revealed at the Time of the End

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The Book of Daniel tells us that there are things that will not be revealed until the time of the end. The understanding of the Book of Revelation will be revealed at the time of the end.

Daniel 12:4 and 9 But you, Daniel, shut up the words, seal the book until the time of the end. . . . Go your way, Daniel, for the words are shut up and sealed until the time of the end.

Daniel foretold that the Lord has decreed 70 weeks of years (490 years) on the Jewish people. The 69th week ended with the crucifixion of the Lord Jesus. The 70th week begins later when the future prince of the Roman people (the beast) comes into power and makes a covenant of peace with the Nation of Israel for 7 years. This covenant of peace will be broken in the middle of the week with the abomination and desolation of the Jewish temple. The breaking of this covenant is the beginning of the tribulation and the wrath of God. There are 3 ½ weeks left in the 70th week of Daniel when the covenant is broken. The beast has power for 3 ½ years to wage war and persecute those who will not bow down and worship him nor take his mark on their hand or forehead. Those who do not take the mark of the beast will not be able to buy or sell.

The Book of Revelation involved 7 seals, 7 trumpets and 7 bowls. When the 7th trumpet is blown in Revelation 11:15, the scripture says it is finished, as the kingdom of this world has become the Kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ. When we get to Revelation 12, the woman after giving birth to the Man-child, flees into the wilderness for 3 ½ years, which is the time of the tribulation and the wrath of God. There cannot be another 3 ½ years after the 7th trumpet in Revelation 11:15. The beast only has power for 3 ½ years.

Revelation 12, 13, and 14 speak of the beast coming into power, angels fly through the air preaching the gospel, warning the people to not take the mark of the beast. The warning to not take the mark of the beast must be given before the opening of the first seal which is the beginning of the tribulation. This means Revelation 12, 13, and 14 must go back and overlap Revelation 4 for the angels to be able to warn the people to not take the mark of the beast.

In 1973 I had a dream that the Lord Jesus was coming for his Bride at the midnight hour. My wife, Ann, myself and our two boys age 8 and 9 got out of bed and walked out onto the porch with knowledge we were going to be raptured to meet the Lord in the air. I was puzzled as to why our two-year-old son was not with us. The Lord

told me to review the scriptures on the Bride of Christ, and that an understanding that was over-looked would come forth. In the gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke, Jesus identifies Himself as the Bridegroom. Jesus did not call His disciples the Bride. He called them wedding guests or attendants.

In Philippians 3:12-14, Paul said that he hopes to win the prize of the high-calling, life on high in Christ Jesus. Paul was not talking about salvation. He knows he has salvation as the scripture says whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved. Paul was hoping to make the mid-night hour resurrection to be part of the Bride of Christ and to follow the Lamb wherever He goes. Jesus did not call His disciples the Bride. At that time, they had not completed the race that Paul ran for with all of his might. The Lord revealed to me that a two-year-old is not capable of running the race for the prize of the high-calling i.e., to be the Bride of Christ.

The Man-child is born before the sun-clothed woman flees into the wilderness for 3 ½ years which is the time of the tribulation and the wrath of God. The Man-child is born before the tribulation begins. Again, it is important to know that Revelation 12, 13, and 14 must go back and overlap Revelation 4 so the angels can warn the people to not take the mark of the beast. The very moment the Man-child is born in Revelation 12 is the very moment a door is opened in heaven in Revelation 4. Suddenly there is a multitude before the throne in Revelation 4 and Revelation 14. Revelation 14 calls this multitude the first-fruits unto the Lamb. This multitude follows the Lamb wherever He goes. It is the Bride that follows the Lamb wherever He goes.

The Man-child is the pre-tribulation rapture and the mid-night hour rapture. The Man-child is the Bride of Christ, who follows the Lamb wherever He goes. I do not wish to imply that anyone in my family has won the race that Paul spoke of.

The Time of the Tribulation

Matthew 24:29-31 speaks of the tribulation being over when the sun is darkened and the moon turned blood-red. When the sixth seal is open, the sun is darkened and the moon turned blood-red. The tribulation is over with the opening of the sixth seal. When the seventh seal is open, it is the beginning of trumpet judgments and the bowl judgments. The trumpet and bowl judgments are not part of the tribulation as they occur after the tribulation. The first five seals cover the time of the tribulation.

Tribulation Saints

Matthew 24:29-31 speaks of the Lord gathering His elect immediately after the tribulation with the sound of the trumpet. These elects are called tribulation saints as they went through the tribulation.

Revelation 7:9 - After this I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, robed in white, with palm branches in their hands. . . . Revelation 7:14 - These are those that came out of the great tribulation and have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

These elects are not the highest order of the redeemed. They do not follow the Lamb wherever He goes. The scripture calls them servants. They serve the Lord day and night. The Man-child is the mid-night hour resurrection, and the pre-tribulation rapture. The Man-child, the Bride of Christ, is the prize of the high-calling that Paul ran race for with all of his might.

Daniel, the Prophet, foretold that there would be things that would not be revealed nor understood until the time of the end. Below is a synopsis of things that the Lord has revealed to me over the years.

1. The 70th week of Daniel begins when the prince of the Roman people make a covenant of peace with Israel for 7 years. This covenant of peace is broken 3 ½ years later with the abomination and desolation of the Jewish temple. The first 3 ½ years of the 70th week are peaceful.
2. The Lord Jesus Christ is coming for His Bride at the mid-night hour before the tribulation begins.
3. The Man-child, the Bride of Christ, is the mid-night hour rapture and the pretribulation rapture. The Man-child is the highest order of the redeemed. They follow the Lamb wherever He goes.
4. The first five seals cover the time of the tribulation.
5. The tribulation begins with the abomination and desolation of the temple when the beast sets himself up in the temple and demands everyone to worship him.
6. Revelation 12, 13, and 14 have to go back and overlap Revelation 4 and run concurrently so the angels can warn the people to not take the mark of beast before the opening of the first seal, which is the beginning of the tribulation.

7. The very moment the Man-child is born in Revelation 12 is the same moment a door is open in heaven in Revelation 4 and there is a multitude before the throne. Revelation 14 calls this multitude is the first-fruits unto the Lamb.
8. The Sun-clothed woman gives birth to the Man-child before the tribulation begins. The woman flees into the wilderness after the birth of the Man-child. The Man-child is born before the tribulation begins.
9. The sun is darkened and the moon turned blood red immediately after tribulation.
10. The tribulation is over with the opening of the 6th seal as the sun is darkened and the moon turned blood red.
11. The elects raptured in Matthew 24:29-31 are tribulation saints. Revelation 7:15 speaks of this group as those that went through the tribulation. They are too numerous to count. They are called servants. They are not part of the Bride. They are not the highest order of the redeemed. They do not follow the Lamb wherever He goes.
12. The trumpet and bowl judgments are not part of the tribulation as they happen after the tribulation. The trumpet and bowl judgments are when the Lord pours out His judgments on those that took the mark of the beast. The trumpet and bowl judgments involved natural events: Sun darkening, water turning to blood, meteors falling, vegetation destroyed, sores on people, scorpion tormenting people, etc.
