

## The Lord is willing to forgive Satan if he would repent

**A number of saints have reported that the Lord is willing to forgive Satan and other evil spirits if they would repent.** The spiritual diary of a contemporary mystic, Sister Natalia of Hungary, was published in the Marian Year of 1988. It was titled "The Victorious Queen of the World" by Two Hearts Books and Publishers. On page 45 is a conversation which the Lord allowed Sr. Natalia to overhear between Him and Satan.

"Once I cried on Jesus' shoulder: "Why did you create hell?" To GKGH, whose sins He forgave. Satan was outraged!

"You are not just! This soul was mine all of his life!" He shouted to Jesus. This one committed so many sins, while I committed only one, and You still created Hell for me.

Jesus then, with unbounded love, told Satan: "Lucifer! Did you ever ask Me for forgiveness?" Then Lucifer, seemingly beside himself, shouted: "That, never! That, I will never do!"

Then Jesus turned to me, "**You see, if he would ask Me for forgiveness only once, Hell would cease to exist.**"

The Lord has changed his mind numerous times in both Old and New Testament and did not do what He originally said He was going to do. If the Lord is willing to forgive Satan and fallen angels, He can obviously do what he wants to do. The Lord's mercy is beyond human understanding.

One of my prayer partners told me that a priest told him that evil spirits cannot repent. He said we need to get a team together to pray for some discernment. From 1990 to 1995 I was having 15 to 20 visions a week in my prayer time. A second prayer partner would come by my house every Friday afternoon after work to pray with me for discernment. Are these visions from the Lord? If so, what was the meaning or the message? This prayer partner had never prayed with me about evil spirits as I did not start dealing with evil spirits until 1998 and 1999. When we got together to pray for discernment on whether evil spirits can repent, we had not even gotten started praying, **when he hollered out really loud and said, "Oh yes, they can repent."**

Someone said, when you force evil spirits to repent, they are not doing it on their own freewill. I asked the Lord about this. The Lord said, "No! My word convicts them and they repent on their own." When I pray in tongues, I am speaking God's word to the spirits, God's words convict them of their sins and the abomination of their ways.

I have been attacked many, many times by evil spirits. They get on top me to try to smother me in my sleep so that I cannot breathe or say the name of Jesus. After being viciously attacked, I asked a prayer partner to pray with me for discernment. He said that I was being attacked by two powerful evil spirits. He said while we were praying, he was stabbed in the back but the knife broke. He was frightened and did not want to continue to pray. I did considerable fasting before getting together with another prayer partner to pray with me. It turned out that one of the two powerful evil spirits was a fallen Archangel. When these two fallen angels repented, they took a multitude of evil spirits with them into the kingdom of heaven.

When I deal with evil spirits, I go after the leader. When the leader repents, all of the other spirits will follow him.

Nine different prayer partners have prayed with me in dealing with evil spirits. Some of my prayer partners have been speaking prophetic messages at charismatic prayer meetings for close to 50 years. A prayer partner with the gift of discernment and the gift of tongues is essential in dealing with evil spirits. I have been dealing with evil spirits for at least 25 years.

**The Lord has told me to not be afraid to cast out evil spirits.** I prefer to fast and encourage them to repent and go into the kingdom. When an evil spirit repents and goes into the kingdom, you do not have to deal with them again. When an exorcist casts out a spirit, he may have to cast him out many, many times, making it a continuous battle.

In my book *Seven Vital Truths for God's Children*, the 9<sup>th</sup> Chapter is about "My Encounter with Angels". I had a vision of thousands and thousands of angels forming a very high and wide dome. There were rows of angels standing side by side forming a tight and wide circle. There were many, many rows of angels on top of other angels all the way to the top of the dome. The Lord said:

Michael, these are My angels that I have chosen for you. They are protection for you and those whom you pray and intercede for. This dome has been built by your prayers and intercessions. The angels come and go as you pray. They each have names but I have given them to you in your name as a gift in these hours. I want you to know that I love you. I call you my love for you are doing as I have instructed you to do. You are about to go on a new journey in prayer. Open yourself to know what I am about to teach you. Listen to the words you will read and study. Make them yours that you may teach others that I will send. This dome of angels moves with you, so go freely as I send or direct you. Your face is becoming that of My Son, Jesus. I love you.

Every morning, I call on all the angels and saints to join me in prayer and to pray for the angels so they will have ammunition to protect us and to fight the power of darkness.

The scripture says narrow is the path that leads to the kingdom of heaven, and broad is the path that leads to destruction. **Jesus told Luisa Piccarreta that with His mercy He is able to get a multitude through the narrow gate while few would be left outside.** – *The Crown of Sanctity by Daniel O'Connor – page 93.*

Evil spirits can repent. God's mercy is beyond human understanding. The Lord is willing to forgive Satan and all evil spirits if they will repent.
